



SOMERLED 2009 'PICNIC RACES RED'

This mid-weight wine is made from cabernet sauvignon grapes grown in the Adelaide Hills region of South Australia. The wine underwent full malolactic fermentation in stainless steel tanks. Bottled under screwcap to seal in freshness. Designed for early drinking.



This is a dry, savoury wine with European influences. It's easy-drinking and approachable, making it a very popular style. Lower in alcohol than our shiraz, it makes a medium-bodied alternative to rose on hot days and can be chilled accordingly.

Our Picnic Races Red is particularly good with chargrilled meats and spicy flavours.

<u>Appearance</u>	Bright, clear and fresh.
<u>Nose</u>	Aromas of fresh cherries and marzipan are not overpowered by oak. Hidden violets and
<u>Palate</u>	The flavour is savoury and fresh, delivering the promise of cherries and berries.
