

SOMERLED 2010 'PICNIC RACES RED'

A typical luncheon, picnic and pizza and pasta wine – lovely bright young colours, soft tannins, light oak and lovely aromas. Different from Rob's traditional big reds, and a wonderful addition to the Somerled stable!

This mid-weight wine is made from 85% cabernet sauvignon grapes grown in the Adelaide Hills region of South Australia – with the new addition this vintage of 15% cabernet franc.



Left on skins for only a short time, so the tannins are soft and create a lovely young wine. Having said that, it'll age very nicely for 7 or 8 years. Lower in alcohol than our shiraz, it makes a robust, medium-bodied alternative to rose on hot days and can be chilled accordingly. The Cab Franc adds that stunning fragrance as soon as you put your nose in the glass. Particularly good with chargrilled meats and spicy flavours.

<u>Appearance</u> Bright, clear and fresh.

Nose Fresh cherries, rose petals and light Adelaide Hills spice.

Palate Soft tannins, a little spice and bright young fruit and floral characters.
