

Somerled 2015 Adelaide Hills Rosé

In 2013 we picked pinot noir fruit from a very high altitude vineyard in Summertown – the very same single vineyard from which we pick our pinot for the Somerled Sparkling – and made an exceptionally elegant and dry rosé.

This year we did so again and the results are outstanding.

We very gently pressed the fruit as you can see from the pale, elegant colour.

Aromas are typical Adelaide Hills pinot - beautifully lifted strawberry.

The palate follows on from those strawberry/pinot characters, but with a supple creaminess as well. I decided to take the wine 100% of the way through malolactic fermentation, which is unusual for a rosé but lends it that complex, interesting mouthfeel which sets this wine apart.
